

COOKIES POLICY

In compliance with Law 34/2002, of 11 July on Information Society Services and E-Commerce, the User is hereby informed of the cookies in use on this website.

Among other things, cookies allow statistical information to be collected, certain technical functions to be provided, information about the browsing habits or preferences of Users or their device to be stored or retrieved, and the User may be recognised (such as their language, country, browser, etc.). If the User does not wish to enable cookies, they may configure their browser to delete them from the hard drive of their computer, disable them, or receive a warning when they are installed.

Our website uses cookies and other related technologies (for convenience, all technologies are called "cookies"). Cookies are also placed by third parties we have contracted. In the following document we inform you about the use of cookies on our website.

What are cookies, scripts or web beacons?

A cookie is a small simple file that is sent along with the pages of this website and that the user's browser stores on the hard drive of their computer or other devices (smartphone, tablet, connected TV...). Stored information may be returned to our servers or relevant third-party servers during a subsequent visit.

A script is a piece of program code that is used to make our website work properly and interactively. This code runs on our server or on the user's device.

A web beacon (or pixel tag) is a small, invisible piece of text or image on a web that is used to track traffic on a website.

Depending on the entity that manages them, cookies can be:

o First-party cookies

First-party cookies are files sent from our servers or domains directly to the user's device. They are originated and managed by us, and their use contributes to the proper functioning and personalization of the user experience.

o Third-party cookies

The Website may use cookies installed by third parties to carry out statistical analysis on users' browsing or to display personalised advertising content. It is important to bear in mind that, in case of accepting third-party cookies, it will be the user's responsibility to delete them from the browser options or through the system provided by the third party itself.

Both, this Website and its legal representatives are not responsible for the content or the veracity of the privacy policies that the third parties mentioned in this cookies policy may have. Web browsers are the tools in charge of storing cookies, and from this place, users must exercise their right to delete or deactivate them. Neither this website nor its legal representatives can guarantee the correct or incorrect manipulation of cookies by these browsers.

Depending on their expiry date, cookies can be:

- o Session Cookies*

Temporary cookies, they remain in the browser's cookie file only for the duration of the session on our website and are not stored on the device after the session or browser is closed.

- o Persistent Cookies*

They store information on the device and remain after you log out or close the browser. They are used to remember information and settings between visits, providing a personalized experience over time.

Depending on their purpose, cookies can be:

- o Technical or functional cookies*

Some cookies ensure that certain parts of the website function properly and that user preferences can be remembered. By placing functional cookies, we make it easier to visit and use our website. In this way, it is not necessary to repeatedly enter the same information when visiting our website and, for example, the items remain in the shopping cart until the user completes the purchase. Regulations allow us to place these cookies without your consent.

- o Analytical cookies*

These cookies are used to optimize the experience on the website. These cookies allow the tracking and analysis of the behavior of website users. The user's consent is required for insertion. This information is valuable for improving and adjusting content and design, ensuring a more efficient and personalized experience.

o Advertising or marketing cookies

They store information on user behavior obtained through the continuous observation of their browsing habits, which allows the development of a specific profile to display advertising based on it. We and third parties collect information about campaign results based on a profile created from user clicks and browsing. With these cookies, the user, as a visitor to the website, is linked to a unique ID. The user's consent is required to insert these cookies.

o Social Media Buttons

These buttons are used to promote pages (e.g. "like", "pin") or share them (e.g. "tweet") on social networks such as Facebook. These buttons work using code from these social networks and this code embeds cookies. These social media buttons may store and process certain information, so that a personalized advertisement can be displayed.

By clicking on these buttons, you accept the use of cookies by these social networks, the relationship of which will be exclusively regulated by the privacy policy of the respective entities. Please read the privacy policy of these social networks (which may change frequently) to find out what they do with your (personal) data that they process using these cookies.
